For A Better World

January 16– February 27

This exhibition presents poems and drawings on peace and justice from the 2006 edition of the book *For a Better World* edited by Saad Ghosn. The show features Greater Cincinnati poets and artists reflecting on current sociopolitical issues and tell the story of Cincinnati, and of a world, in change and in progress.

Our annual student art exhibition features imaginative works and inspired creations from both youth and adult classes at Kennedy Heights Art Center. I See Africa

April 17 – June 5

Nigerian photographer Dr. Alfred Olusegun Fayemi presents a social photographic documentary of continental Africans and Africans in the Diaspora, a social dispersion of people, language, and culture. Other diverse artists respond to the theme *realities, perceptions and imaginings of Africa* with exhibited work including traditional African art and contemporary impressions. This groundwork exhibit begins an annual tradition that celebrates Cincinnati communities and encourages cultural reconciliation.

Guild Summer Show

June 12 – August 14

This exclusive summer exhibition features the talented Kennedy Guild Artists as they present unique creations featuring photography, painting, jewelry, sculpture, and fiber arts.

Brenda Tarbell

August 21 – September 25

Inspired by the natural world, featured artist Brenda Tarbell presents a tactile, interactive exhibit that invites viewers to a “hands-on” experience that entices the senses. Pieces include Braille and ceramic garden sculpture destined for sensitive exploration as well as photographs highlighting children’s responses to the series.

October 2 – November 13

Our sixth annual juried exhibition *Click VI* is entirely devoted to the medium of photography. Featured is the *One and Only Show* by the Ohio Valley Chapter of the American Society of Media Photographers. Explore interpretations of an innocuous object as artists incorporate and record that image through the photographic medium.

A holiday exhibition offering unique handmade treasures presented by the Kennedy Artists Guild features pieces that include painting, photography, jewelry, ceramics, fiber creations, mosaics, and sculpture.
