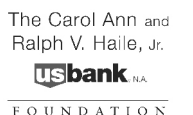
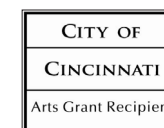
3. Walk-in registration: During our business hours, Mondays through Saturdays 10 am - 4 pm.
