### Featured Artists of the month

#### Kathy Kuyper: Watercolor Artist

Her soft, subtle blend of colors combined with her creative use of the white paper develops paintings of landscapes and wildlife. One of her limited-edition hand painted Christmas ornaments depicts the KHAC and is donated to The Giving Tree.

#### Jackie Bonfield: Hand-Crafted Jewelry

Jackie creates her own beads and pendants with acrylic polymer clay some of which are wrapped with wire in an abstract and functional setting. Careful shaping of each piece fused with colors yields earrings, necklaces and bracelets of unique design.

#### Deb Ward: Watercolor Artist

Deb's large, crisp watercolor paintings depict a wide variety of subjects from train engines to old cars. She paints nostalgia, memories of a bygone time or of favorite trips. "With few exceptions", she says, "when you look at my work you know exactly what you are looking at... nothing too deep!"
