## Black History Month Special Events at KHAC

In celebration of Black History Month, the Kennedy Heights Arts Center will be hosting a free production of Cincinnati Opera's "This Little Light of Mine: Two Legends, One Dream" on Wednesday, February 20th at 7:00 pm. This show is a multi-media musical tribute to Marian Anderson and Leontyne Price, two African-American opera icons. Both young people and families will be inspired during this special presentation that is touring the Tri-state during February.

Ms. Anderson and Ms. Price let their lights shine through the chaos and racism of the Civil Rights movement. Through stories and song, "This Little Light of Mine" chronicles their struggles and celebrates their achievements and positive influences during this tumultuous time in American history.
