### Alternative Photography Methods

Ever wish you could actually share some of your garden with distant friends? What if your stationery could incorporate the garden outside your window? Handmade papers offer just that possibility.

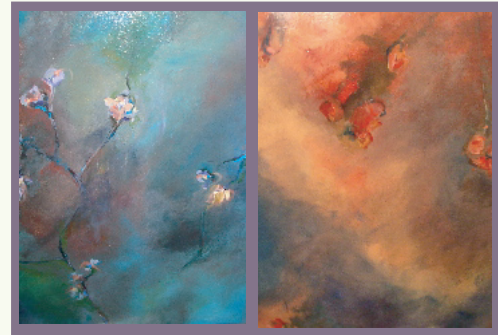
The Kennedy Heights Arts Center is offering a hands-on demonstration of papermaking with natural inclusions by Maxine Apke the creator of Deckle2go, a papermaking program for art teachers. "Papermaking with Natural Inclusions: How to Do It and How to Teach It," part of the Art in the Garden Series, will take place Saturday April 7th, from 9:30-11:30 a.m.

Ms Apke, a teacher with 23 years of experience, will be demonstrating how to include natural objects such as flowers and leaves in one-of-a-kind handmade papers. She will also discuss techniques for teaching these processes. This craft incorporates the beauty of the garden in a very special way. Materials will be provided, but students are urged to bring a notepad and a camera to capture the variety of handmade papers Ms Apke will exhibit.
